

The following strategy will assist children in writing the main events with specific details. On the next two pages, you will view examples of the **Event-Details** strategy.

Event-Details Example

Event	Details
First, standing in front of me was a mean looking leprechaun.	He was as quiet as a mouse. The leprechaun stood two feet tall and his wrinkled face was bright green. His dark eyes glared at me with such intensity. Then, the leprechaun walked slowly toward me. His tiny hands reached out to grab me.

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Suddenly, I dashed into a field.	It had many colorful flowers and short thorny bushes. The ground was soft and damp. My slender legs grew tired and I was out of breath. I was so exhausted that my body collapsed to the ground. I was lying in a field of four-leaf clovers.

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
